## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 105TH LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1373, L. D. 1790, Bill, "AN ACT to Revise the Site Location of Development Law."

Amend said Bill in section 4 in that part designated "§ 483." by inserting after the first sentence the following: 'Prior to the adoption and use of any new form hereunder the commission shall hold a public hearing in Augusta, after having given 30 days public notice thereof in the official state newspaper, for the purpose of giving all interested parties an opportunity of examining the proposed form and for testifying thereon.'

Further amend said Bill in section 9 in that part designated "§ 488." in the 2nd line (same in L.D.) by inserting after the word "apply" the underlined words 'to any land leased solely for the cultivation and production of crops or for the grazing of livestock or'

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to allow the public a role in developing site location application forms and to make it clear that the Site Location of Development Law does not apply to certain types of agricultural activity.
