HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 1373, L. D. 1790, Bill, "AN ACT to Revise the Site Location of Development Law."

Amend said Bill in section 2 by striking out in subsection 2 all of the last 2 underlined sentences.

Further amend said Bill in section 3 by striking out all of subsection 5 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'5. Subdivision. "Subdivision" means the division of a parcel or tract or land into 3 or more parcels, whether this division is accomplished by platting the land or by a sale of the land by metes and bounds or by leasing the land.

Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this amendment to redefine development which may substantially affect environment and the meaning of subdivisions.
