HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 1374, L. D. 1791, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Certain Laws Relative to Great Ponds."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 3 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 3. R. S., T. 12, § 2205, amended. Section 2205 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows: § 2205. Bulldozing of rivers, streams and brooks

Whoever bulldozes or causes to be bulldozed between the banks of a river, stream or brook in-excess-of-500-feet-in length-in-any-one-mile,-measured-along-the-thread-of-the-stream, without first obtaining permission therefor from the commissioner, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$100 nor more than \$1,000. This section shall not apply to river, stream or brook crossings or public works projects.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of the amendment is to permit stream crossing and to exempt public works projects.
