HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 1374,
L.D. 1791, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Certain Laws Relative to
Great Ponds."

Amend said Amendment in the 4th blocked paragraph of that
part designated paragraph "B" by striking out in the 9th and 10th
lines the underlined words and figures "not less than \$200 nor
more than \$100" and inserting in place thereof the underlined
words and figures 'not more than \$200'

Further amend said Amendment in the last line before the
Statement of Fact by inserting before the period the following
underlined words and punctuation: ', nor to such crossings in
connection with private ways which shall alter not more than 100
feet of shore'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to correct an error in the
amount of the fine and to exempt from section 2205 certain crossings
in connection with private ways.
