HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 613, L. D. 1793, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Test Operations for Double Bottom Trucks."

Amend said Bill in section 3 by striking out all of the
last paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Only one trailer or semitrailer shall be drawn by a motor
vehicle; provided that driveaway, towaway operations, as
defined by the Public Utilities Commission, may include a
combination of saddlemount vehicles not to exceed 3 units in
contact with surface of the highway; specifically excepting test
operations described in this section which are permitted by the
State Highway Commission during the 2-year test period provided.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to allow 2-year test periods.
