**AN ACT to Provide for the Taxation of Pulpwood and Logs in Place Where
Situated.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 36, § 603, sub-§ 2, ¶ A, amended. Paragraph A of subsection 2 of section 603 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

A. Portable mills ~~logs in any place to be manufactured therein~~ and all manufactured lumber excepting lumber in the possession of a transportation company and in transit.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 36, § 603, sub-§ 2, ¶ A-1, additional. Subsection 2 of section 603 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new paragraph A-1, to read as follows:

A-1. Pulpwood and logs.
