HOUSE AMENDMENT "C " to H. P. 1388, L. D. 1811, Bill,
"AN ACT Making Supplemental Appropriations for the Expenditures
of State Government and for Other Purposes for the Fiscal Years
Ending June 30, 1972 and June 30, 1973 and Raising Revenue for
Funding Thereof."

Amend said Bill in Section A under the caption "HEALTH AND
WELFARE, DEPARTMENT OF" by striking out the 6th and 7th lines
(7th and 8th in L.D.) and inserting in place thereof the following:

Further amend said Bill in Section A under the caption "HEALTH
AND WELFARE, DEPARTMENT OF" by striking out the last line and
inserting in place thereof the following:

Further amend said Bill in Section D by striking out in the
3rd line from the end (same in L.D.) the underlined figure "20"
and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '21'
