SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1391, L. D. 1813, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to the Possession and Sale of Certain Hallucinogenic Drugs."

Amend said Bill in section 2 by striking out in the 8th and 9th
lines (7th line of L. D.) the underlined words, figures and punctuation
"and research centers and laboratories licensed under section 2368-A,"

Further amend said Bill in section 3 by striking out in the 6th
and 7th lines (5th line in L. D.) the underlined words, figures and
punctuation "and research centers and laboratories licensed under
section 2368-A,"

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 5
and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 5. R. S., T. 22, §2368-A, repealed. Section 2368-A of
Title 22 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 8 of chapter
390 of the public laws of 1967 and as amended by section 6 of chapter 443
of the public laws of 1969, is repealed.

Sec. 6. R. S., T. 22, §2369, amended. The first paragraph
of section 2369 of Title 22 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by
section 9 of chapter 390 of the public laws of 1967, is further
amended to read as follows:

No license shall be issued under section 2368 ~~or section 2368-A,~~
unless and until the applicant therefor has furnished proof satisfactory
to the Bureau of Health.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to repeal the provisions of the
bill relating to laboratories and research centers.
