STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Amend Biennial Elections of Penobscot Tribe of Indians.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 22, § 4792, amended. The first 2 sentences of section 4792 of Title 22 of the Revised Statutes are repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

Whenever any vacancy occurs in the office of governor, lieutenant governor, council and representative at the Legislature, there shall be a special election called by the commissioner within 60 days to fill such vacancy. Governor, lieutenant governor, council and representative at the Legislature may be removed from office by a petition of the immediate past election of the majority of votes cast of the Penobscot Tribe providing a presentation of charges are presented in writing to the governor, lieutenant governor, council and representative at the Legislature and a formal hearing with the majority of registered voters of the previous election.
