HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to H. P. 1400, L. D. 1817, Bill, "AN ACT to Relieve Certain Elderly Householders from the Extraordinary Impact of Property Taxes."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end of section 1, the following:

§ 6118. Protection from loss of benefits

It is the intent of the Legislature that any claim paid under this chapter shall supplement any benefits paid under Aid to the Aged, Blind and Disabled or any program which succeeds or supplants it. The Department of Health and Welfare shall take any such action as may be necessary to assure that recipients of Aid to the Aged, Blind and Disabled shall not incur any loss or reduction of assistance from such programs.

It is the purpose of this amendment to indicate the intent of the Legislature.
