## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 105TH LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to H. P. 1400, L. D. 1817, Bill,

"AN ACT to Relieve Certain Elderly Householders from the Extraordinary

Impact of Property Taxes."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 3 the following:

'Sec. 4. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Welfare for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1973 the sum of \$600,000. The breakdown shall be as follows:

1972-73

HEALTH AND WELFARE, DEPARTMENT OF

Aid to Aged, Blind or Disabled

All Other

600,000

Provides funds to increase standards for aged, blind, or disabled under state programs. This appropriation will bring in \$1,200,000 in Federal funds. Maine citizens under these programs will not benefit under L.D. 1817, "AN ACT to Relieve Certain Elderly Householders from the Extraordinary Impact of Property Taxes." This amendment will take care of this group of people.

Sec. 5. Finance and Administration; appropriation. Any appropriation to the Department of Finance and Administration, Bureau of Taxation, for tax relief for the elderly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1973 appropriated by the 105th Legislature in regular session shall be decreased in the amount of \$600,000.' Filed by Mr. Cyr of Madawaska.
