SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 633, L. D. 1821, Bill, "AN ACT Transferring Duties of the Art Commission to the Commission on the Arts and Humanities and the State Museum."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 1. R. S., T. 27, § 87, amended. Section 87 of Title 27 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 502 of the public laws of 1965, is amended by adding at the end the following new sentence:

The Maine State Commission on the Arts and Humanities shall furnish the Maine State Museum Commission with such assistance as necessary to administer section 86-A.'


Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end before the period in section 2 the underlined words 'but shall not include "historical materials" administered by the Maine State Museum Commission'

Further amend said Bill in the last 2 lines (same in L.D.) by striking out the words and figures "the Revised Statutes, Title 27, section 83, subsection 5" and inserting in place thereof the following: 'restoration and conservation of state-owned paintings in accordance with section 86-A'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify the duties of the Maine State Museum Commission and the Commission on the Arts and the Humanities.
