SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1417, L. D. 1836, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Establishment of a State Building Code.

Amend said Bill in the 11th, 12th and 13th lines (9th and 10th in L.D.) by striking out the underlined words and punctuation "and the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, hereinafter referred to as "HUD""


Further amend said Bill in the 20th line (16th in L.D.) by striking out the underlined words "and HUD"

Further amend said Bill in the 29th line (24th in L.D.) by inserting before the period the punctuation and words ', provided that such ordinances are enacted after the effective date of this Act'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to more clearly define the code to be adopted and to clarify what action municipalities must take in order to exceed the BOCA Code.
