SENATE AMENDMENT " B " to H. P. 1417, L. D. 1836, Bill, "AN
ACT Relating to Establishment of a State Building Code."

Amend said Bill in that part designated subparagraph (9)
by striking out in the first line (same in L.D.) the underlined
words "and enforce"

Further amend said Bill in that part designated subparagraph
(9) by striking out all of the last underlined sentence of the
first paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:
'In the event that a municipality has no building inspector the
municipality need not enforce this subparagraph.'
