SEVENTY-ONE

RESOLVE, to Apportion One Hundred and Fifty-One Representatives Among the Several Counties, Cities, Towns, Plantations and Unorganized Territory of the State.

Apportionment of Representatives to the Legislature. Whereas, in accordance with Article IV, Part 1, Sections 2 and 3 of the Constitution of Maine, the Legislature has ascertained the number of inhabitants of the State to be 993,663; now, therefore, be it

Resolved: That for the 106th Legislature to and including 1982:

Androscoggin. The County of Androscoggin, having a population of 91,279, shall choose 14 Representatives; and the unit base number for said county being 6,520, said Representatives shall be apportioned as follows:
