HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 1423, L. D. 1848, Bill,
"AN ACT to Reorganize the Department of Education."

Amend said Bill in section 2 in the 2nd and 3rd lines
of the 2nd paragraph (2nd in L.D.) by striking out the
words "will sit as an advisory board to" and inserting in
place thereof the word 'shall'

Further amend said Bill in section 2 in the 6th line
from the end of the 2nd paragraph (5th line in L.D.) by
striking out the word "advisory"

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to eliminate the
provision of the bill which provides that the Board of
Education shall be an advisory board.
