HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 663, L. D. 1858, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Employment Security Law to Conform to Federal Requirements."

Amend said Bill in section 38 in the 6th line from the end (same in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word "chapter" the underlined words 'and who employ 3 or less employees'

Further amend said Bill in section 38 in the 7th line from the end (6th line in L.D.) by striking out the underlined figure "2%" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '1%'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to change the 2% rate to 1% for those employers who employ 3 or less employees.
