SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 688, L. D. 1869, Bill, "AN ACT to Create a Crime Laboratory."


Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the Un-appropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$409,042 to the State Police to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
