COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 691, L. D. 1872, Resolve,
to Reimburse Certain Persons for Displacement Costs Because of
Property Taken by State.

Amend said resolve by striking out everything after the
Title and before the statement of fact and inserting in place
thereof the following:

'Displacement costs for certain persons; reimbursed. Resolved:
That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum
of \$8,000 to reimburse the following persons in the amounts indicated
for displacement and moving costs in connection with properties
taken in the construction of I-295 in Portland:
