SENATE AMENDMENT " A "to S. P. 696, L. D. 1877, Bill, "AN ACT Increasing Membership of State Parole Board."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 2. R. S., T. 34, §1551, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 1551 of Title 34 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows: ~~Two~~ Three of the members shall be appointed by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Council, from persons with special training or experience in law, sociology, psychology or related branches of social science.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting before the Emergency clause the following:

'Sec. 3. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the State Parole Board the sum of \$2,000 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
