STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-TWO

AN ACT Relating to Municipal Regulation of Snowmobiles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 1972, amended. The 2nd sentence of the next to the last paragraph of section 1972 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 414 of the public laws of 1969, is repealed as follows:

No municipality or political subdivision of this State may adopt any ordinance, law or regulation dealing with the operation or registration of snow-mobiles or any other subject matter of this chapter.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to repeal the provision which prohibits municipalities from regulating the operation of snowmobiles.
