SENATE AMENDMENT " A" to S. P. 699, L. D. 1880, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to the Change of Name of Junior Achievement of
Greater Portland, Inc."

Amend said Bill in the Title by inserting before the period
the following: 'and to the Change of Name of Maine Council of the
Blind to the National Federation of the Blind of Maine'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the
first line after the enacting clause the underlined abbreviation
and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end before the
Statement of Fact the following:

'Sec. 2. Change of name. The name of Maine Council of the
Blind, a corporation organized under the Maine Revised Statutes
of 1954, chapter 54, is changed to the National Federation of the
Blind of Maine.

Sec. 3. Copy to be recorded. A copy of section 2 of this
Act shall be recorded in the records of the Secretary of State
and the Registry of Deeds of Kennebec County in the same manner as
certificates of incorporation are recorded.'


Statement of Fact

The Revised Statutes, Title 13, section 982 does not permit
the use of the name of the State in the title of a charitable
institution or association of a private or of a semi-public nature

(Filing No. S-334)

incorporated after July 11, 1913. The Maine Council of the Blind desires to change its name to "National Federation of the Blind of Maine" and the purpose of this amendment is to authorize, in the usual manner, the use of the name of the State in such new name.
