**AN ACT Relating to Town's Matching Funds for Resurfacing
State Aid Highways.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., T. 23, § 1104, amended. The first paragraph of section 1104 of Title 23 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended to read as follows :

If any town shall in a single year increase its appropriation for state aid roads to an amount of 4 or 6 times the maximum amount which it may annually appropriate under section 1101 for use only in reconstructing or **resurfacing** improved state aid highways, the commission shall from any balance of said fund for state aid highways, and subject to section 1105, apportion a like increase of state aid.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to amend the law relating to town's matching funds for reconstructing state aid highways to include resurfacing state aid highways.
