SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P.
1450, L. D. 1893, Bill, "AN ACT Reallocating Funds for Professional
Contractual Employees for the Joint Standing Committees of the
Legislature."

Amend said Amendment by inserting before the 3rd paragraph
from the end, before the Statement of Fact, the following:

'Sec. 3-A. R. S., T. 3, §2, amended. The 4th paragraph of
section 2 of Title 3 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is
further amended to read as follows:

When In addition to the salary paid for the regular session of
the Legislature, when an extra session is called, the members of
the Senate and House of Representatives shall each be paid \$25 for
every day's attendance, and mileage as aforesaid.'


Further amend said Amendment by striking out all of the next
to the last paragraph, before the Statement of Fact, and inserting
in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 5. Effective date. Sections 2, 3, 3-A and 4 of this Act
shall take effect on the first Wednesday of January, 1973.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify the bill so that at
a special session the Members of the Legislature will receive
their per diem allowance in addition to their salary.
