SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P.
1450, L. D. 1893, Bill, "AN ACT Reallocating Funds for Professional
Contractual Employees for the Joint Standing Committees of the
Legislature."

Amend said Amendment by inserting at the end of the first
paragraph after the word "Legislature" the words 'and Indian
Representatives at the Legislature'

Further amend said Amendment by inserting before the 3rd paragraph
from the end, before the Statement of Fact, the following:

'Sec. 3-B. R. S., T. 3, §2, amended. The last paragraph
of section 2 of Title 3 of the Revised Statutes, as amended,
is further amended to read as follows:

The member of the Penobscot Indian Tribe and the member of the
Passamaquoddy Indian Tribe elected to represent his tribe at the
biennial assembly of the Legislature shall receive a compensation
of \$650 \$1,500 for such attendance and travel at each legislative
session for 20 trips to and from his place of abode at the same
rate as state employees receive, and allowance for meals and
housing expenses as any other member of the Senate and House of
Representatives for 20 days' attendance at each legislative session.'

Further amend said Amendment by striking out all of the next to
the last paragraph, before the Statement of Fact, and inserting
in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 5. Effective date. Sections 2, 3, 3-B and 4 of this
Act shall take effect on the first Wednesday of January, 1973.'
