RESOLVE, Providing for Purchase of Copies of Cyr Plantation Centennial.

Copies of Cyr Plantation Centennial; purchase of. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$400 for the State to purchase 100 copies of the book "Cyr Plantation Centennial" by Mrs. Alpha Lebasseur; said books to be exchanged or distributed at the discretion of the State Librarian.

STATEMENT OF FACT

It has been the custom and practice of the Legislature to encourage historical books, which help to preserve the history of Maine, by purchasing copies for distribution.
