SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 1468,
L. D. 1911, Bill, "AN ACT to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies
in the Education Laws."

Amend said Amendment by striking out all of subsection 3
of that part designated "§805." and inserting in place thereof
the following:

'3. Officials. An official, in the course of his duties,
of a public, private or parochial elementary or secondary school
where the pupil attends or has attended or intends to enroll;'


Further amend said Amendment by striking out all of subsection
5 of that part designated "§805." and inserting in place thereof
the following:

'5. Education officials. The Commissioner of Education,
or a member of his staff, or the superintendent of schools, or
a member of his staff, in the course of his duties, where the
pupil attends, has attended or intends to enroll;'
