HOUSE AMENDMENT " F" to H. P. 1468, L. D. 1911, Bill, "AN ACT to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in the Education Laws."

Amend said Bill by inserting after the enacting clause the following:

'Sec. 1. R. S., T. 20, §226, sub-§4, ¶A, amended. Paragraph A of subsection 4 of section 226 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

A. Each person whose name appears on the ~~district-voting-list~~ municipal voting list of the municipalities within the district may attend and vote at a district budget meeting. The town or city clerk shall deliver to the secretary of the School Administrative District, prior to the district budget meeting, a certified corrected copy of the voting list of the member municipality of the district.'

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 20, §226, sub-§4, ¶C, amended. Paragraph C of subsection 4 of section 226 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 4 of chapter 196 of the public laws of 1971, is further amended by adding at the end 2 new sentences to read as follows:

The moderator shall appoint from the certified voting list such ballot clerks as he deems necessary for the efficient operation of the meeting. Such ballot clerks shall be sworn by the moderator.

Sec. 3. R. S., T. 20, §226, sub-§5, repealed and replaced.

Subsection 5 of section 226 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

5. Registration. Registration of voters for the district budget meeting shall be held in each member municipality in accordance with the time schedule specified in Title 21, section 631, subsection 3, regardless of population, notwithstanding any other provision of statute.'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections 1 to 7 to be sections 4 to 10.

This amendment clarifies the law regulating registration of voters at school district budget meetings.
