SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 1470, L. D. 1913, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Penalty for Dogs Killing or Wounding Wild
Animals."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first
line after the enacting clause the underlined abbreviation and
figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end before
the Statement of Fact the following:

'Sec. 2. R. S., T. 7, § 3602, amended. Section 3602 of
Title 7 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 2 of
chapter 404 of the public laws of 1967, is further amended by
adding after the 2nd paragraph a new paragraph to read as
follows:

The owner or keeper of any bird dog, retrieving dog or
hound found killing or wounding any deer or moose during the
period in which it is lawful to train dogs as provided for in
sections 3551 and 3553, while said dog is at a licensed dog
training area, or at a licensed trial for retrieving dogs, shall
be subject to the penalties as provided in Title 12, section 3060.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide a penalty when
certain dogs kill or wound wild animals.
