STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-TWO

AN ACT Relating to Closed Season on Deer on Swan Island, Hancock County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2353, amended. The 8th paragraph of section 2353 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

There shall be a continual closed season on deer on all of Swan Island in the Town of Swan's Island, located in the County of Hancock except that it shall be lawful to hunt with bow and arrow in accordance with chapter 322 during the month of October and the month of November of each calendar year.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide for a continual closed season on deer on Swan Island, including hunting with bow and arrow.
