**AN ACT Permitting Veterans with Medical Experience to
Take the Licensed Practical Nurses Examination.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 32, § 2251, sub-§ 6, additional. Section 2251 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection 6 to read as follows:

6. Medical training; veterans. Has successfully completed the training requirements of an organized military medical assistant course and has had at least 2 years' experience under nursing supervisor.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 32, § 2259, repealed. Section 2259 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 7 of chapter 263 of the public laws of 1967, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to allow veterans who have had medical training and experience while serving in the Armed Forces to take the licensed practical nurses examination.
