AN ACT to Promote Vocational Education.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 26, § 1043, sub-§ 11, ¶ F, sub-¶ (6-1), additional. Paragraph F of subsection 11 of section 1043 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new subparagraph (6-1) to read as follows:

(6-1) Services performed by an individual while registered for a prescribed course at any educational institution on a cooperative program of education and industrial training.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill exempts from unemployment compensation coverage students who are enrolled in an educational course involving cooperative on-the-job training.
