RESOLVE, Reimbursing Neil Harmon of Steep Falls for Snowmobile Damage Sustained Through Negligence of State Ward.

Neil Harmon; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$350 to reimburse Neil Harmon of Steep Falls for damages sustained to his snowmobile by the negligence of a minor child committed to the custody of the Department of Health and Welfare.

STATEMENT OF FACT

On December 14, 1971, Mr. Harmon's snowmobile was taken by a state ward who, through negligence, was responsible for its destruction by fire. The loss totaled \$500. Department policies have already permitted a reimbursement of \$150. This bill seeks to appropriate to Mr. Harmon the remaining amount due him.
