L. D. 1937, Bill, "AN ACT Authorizing Town of Dresden to Vote on
Certain Liquor Local Option Questions."

Amend said amendment in the 8th and 9th lines by striking
out the following: "'at the annual town meeting in March, 1972.'" .
and inserting in place thereof: 'at a special town meeting to be
held not less than 30 days nor more than 60 days following the
effective date of this Act.'
