HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1494, L. D. 1937, Bill,
"AN ACT Authorizing Town of Dresden to Vote on Certain Liquor
Local Option Questions."

Amend said Bill in the 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th lines after the
enacting clause (4th, 5th, 6th and 7th lines in L.D.) by
striking out the punctuation and words ", in the manner prescribed
for the calling and holding of biennial meetings of said
inhabitants for the election of Senators and Representatives,
at a special meeting to be held within 90 days after the
effective date of this Act" and inserting in place thereof the
words, punctuation and figures 'at the annual town meeting in
March, 1972'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the last 2
lines before the emergency clause and inserting in place
thereof the following:

'The result of the vote shall be declared by the municipal
officers of the Town of Dresden and due certificate thereof
shall be filed by the town clerk with the Secretary of State.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide that the vote
shall be taken at the annual town meeting in March, 1972.
