## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 105TH LEGISLATURE FIRST SPECIAL SESSION

HOUSE AMENDMENT "C"to H. P. 1494, L. D. 1937, Bill, "AN ACT Authorizing Town of Dresden to Vote on Certain Liquor Local Option Questions."

Amend said Bill in the Title by inserting at the end before the period, the following:

'and Authorizing Town of Cornville to Vote on Certain Liquor Local Option Questions'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill in the 8th line after the enacting clause (6th line of L. D.) after the words "effective date of" by inserting the words and number 'section 1 of'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end before the emergency clause the following:

'Sec. 3. Town of Cornville authorized to vote on certain liquor local option questions. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the selectmen of the Town of Cornville, Somerset County, are empowered and directed to notify the inhabitants of the Town of Cornville to meet, in the manner prescribed for the calling and holding of biennial meetings of said inhabitants for the election of Senators and Representatives, at a special meeting to be held within 90 days after the effective date of section 3 of this Act, to give their votes upon the following questions:

1. Shall licenses be granted in this Town for sale herein of wine and spirits to be consumed on the premises? (Hotel and Club)

- 2. Shall licenses be granted in this Town for sale herein of malt liquor (beer, ale and other malt liquors) to be consumed on the premises?

  (Beer and Ale in Restaurants, Hotels and Clubs)
- 3. Shall licenses be granted in this Town for sale herein of wine and spirits to be consumed on the premises of Class A restaurants?

The purpose of this amendment is to permit local option on 3 liquor questions in the Town of Cornville, Somerset County.
