STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-TWO

AN ACT Relating to Filling Vacancies in Board of Trustees of Sanford Sewerage District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1947, c. 169, § 6, amended. The last sentence of the 2nd paragraph of section 6 of chapter 169 of the private and special laws of 1947 is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

If a vacancy occurs more than 3 months before the next annual election, said vacancy or vacancies shall be filled by the appointment of a qualified voter of the Town of Sanford by the selectmen of the Town of Sanford for the remaining period until the next annual election.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to save the Town of Sanford the cost of calling a special election when a vacancy occurs more than 3 months before the next annual election in the board of trustees of the Sanford Sewerage District.
