HOUSE AMENDMENT " A" to H.P.1504, L.D.1946, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Housing and Food Supplies Furnished by State
Departments."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the first paragraph
after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the
following:

'R.S., T. 5, §§ 8-A - 8-G, additional. Title 5 of the
Revised Statutes is amended by adding 7 new sections, 8-A to
8-G, to read as follows:'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§8-A."
by striking out all of the 2nd underlined sentence and inserting
in place thereof the following:

'To aid in accomplishing this purpose and due to improved travel
conditions and communications, housing for state employees at
State institutions and other areas of State Government and
commissaries operated by State departments for the sale of food
and food supplies to state employees shall be controlled as set
forth in sections 8-B and 8-C respectively.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting after that part designated
"§8-E." the following:

'§ 8-F. Exemption

Sections 8-A to 8-G shall not apply to the Baxter State Park
Authority.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out in that part designated "§8-F." the following: "§8-F. Penalty" and inserting in place thereof the following: '§8-G. Penalty'
