HOUSE AMENDMENT " B " to H. P. 1504, L. D. 1946, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Housing and Food Supplies Furnished by State Departments."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first
line after the enacting clause the underlined abbreviation and
figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end, before the
Emergency clause, the following:

'Sec. 2. R. S., T. 3, §342, amended. The first paragraph of
section 342 of Title 3 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding
at the end the following new sentences:

A rental charge shall be made by the Bureau of Public Improvements
to cover the total operating cost of such facilities. These costs
shall include, but not be limited to, maintenance costs and expenses
for electricity, heat and furnishings.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of the amendment is to provide a rental charge for
facilities used by representatives of the press.
