

## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 105TH LEGISLATURE FIRST SPECIAL SESSION

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to 1508, L. D. 1950, RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution to Reduce the Age of Qualification as a Member of the Maine House of Representatives to Twenty Years."

Amend said Resolution in the Title by striking out the word "Twenty" and inserting in place thereof the word 'Eighteen'

Further amend said Resolution by striking out in the 9th line (same in L. D.) the underlined word "<u>twenty</u>" and inserting in place thereof the underlined word 'eighteen'

Further amend said Resolution by striking out all of the question and inserting in place thereof the following:

'"Shall the Constitution be amended as proposed by a resolution of the Legislature to reduce the age of qualification as a Member of the House of Representatives to eighteen years?"'
