COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1517, L. D. 1959, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify the Laws on Veterans Reemployment Rights in Public Service."

Amend said Bill by adding a new sentence at the end of the first paragraph after the amending clause to read as follows:

'Temporary for the purpose of this section shall be defined to mean employment based on a seasonal or on-call basis or employment based on a contract of less than 6 months, duration.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the 5th, 6th and 7th lines (5th and 6th lines of L.D.) of the second paragraph after the amending clause, the following underlined words and punctuation:

" and,notwithstanding any other provision of chapters 51, 53, 55, 57, 61 and 101 or Title 20,"

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify beyond any doubt the distinction between temporary as used in this legislation and temporary as it might be interpreted as applied to probationary teachers and to ensure that the last paragraph of section 555 of Title 5 is not repealed by implication.
