SENATE AMENDMENT " A "to H.P. 1519, L. D.1961, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Educational Assistance for Certain Widows, Wives, Orphans
and Children of Veterans and Wives and Children of Prisoners of War."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the second line (first line
of L.D.) of 3rd paragraph of the Emergency preamble the word "not"

Further amend said Bill by adding before the Emergency clause
the following:

'Sec. 3. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General
Fund to the Department of Education the sum of \$15,000 for the/^{fiscal}year
ending June 30, 1972 and the sum of \$22,500 for the/^{fiscal}year ending June 30,
1973. The breakdown shall be as follows:

All Other	\$15,000	\$22,500'
