HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 1520, L. D. 1962, Resolve,  
Providing a Minimum Service Retirement Under the State Retirement  
Law for Marion Gates of Phillips.

Amend said resolve in the title by inserting before the  
period the punctuation and words '; Mae A. Bowden of Coopers  
Mills and Edith Wiggin Carter of Topsham'

Further amend said resolve in the 2nd line of the 3rd  
paragraph (first and 2nd lines of 3rd paragraph of L.D.) by striking  
out the name "Marion Gates" and inserting in place thereof the  
words 'certain elderly school teachers'

Further amend said resolve in the first line of the 5th  
paragraph (same in L.D.) by inserting after the word "Phillips"  
the punctuation and words '; Mae A. Bowden of Coopers Mills and  
Edith Wiggin Carter of Topsham'

Further amend said resolve in the 4th line of the 5th paragraph  
(3rd line of L.D.) by inserting after the word "Phillips" the  
punctuation and words ', Mae A. Bowden of Coopers Mills and Edith  
Wiggin Carter of Topsham' and by striking out the word "her" in  
the 4th line (same in L.D.) and inserting in place thereof the  
word 'their' and by striking out in the 5th line (same in L.D.)  
the word "her" and inserting in place thereof the word 'them'

Further amend said Resolve by striking out the period in the last line before the emergency clause and inserting in place thereof the following: '; and be it further

Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Fund to the Maine State Retirement System the sum of \$14,049 to carry out the purposes of this resolve.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide funds to implement this resolve.

Mae A. Bowden of Coopers Mills taught in the public schools of Maine for a little less than 10 years and is presently 88 years of age. Her only income is a small Social Security allowance.

Edith Wiggin Carter of Topsham taught in the public schools of Maine for over 10 years and is now 82 years of age. Her small income is from Social Security and a veterans pension.
