STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-TWO

AN ACT Providing Funds to Town of Mattawamkeag to Construct Municipal Buildings Destroyed by Fire.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the Town of Mattawamkeag which lost its school building and fire station and the contents of each by fire; and

Whereas, the town is in dire economic straits and needs financial help in order to continue to survive; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation. There is appropriated to the Town of Mattawamkeag from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$45,000 to aid the town in constructing municipal buildings destroyed by fire.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.
