COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 1527, L. D. 1970, Bill,
"AN ACT Permitting the Commissioner of Education to Assign Towns
to Supervisory Units when Fewer than 35 Teachers are Employed."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the emergency preamble
and the emergency clause.

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of subsection
6 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'6. Enlarging supervision. Whenever a town has fewer than
35 teachers, the commissioner may add the town to an existing
supervisory unit notwithstanding any other provision of this
chapter, for supervision only.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to authorize the commissioner to
assign towns to school unions for the purpose of school supervision.
