**RESOLVE, to Reimburse Cyril A. Talbot for Damage Due to
Highway Maintenance.**

Cyril A. Talbot; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund to Cyril A. Talbot of Winslow the sum of \$500 for damage to rug due to highway maintenance.

STATEMENT OF FACT

In the summer of 1971, Rt. 27 at Sugarloaf was tarred by the State Highway Commission. Mr. Talbot's camp is located on this highway. Without knowing of the tarring, the camp was entered at night by Mr. Talbot, who walked into his camp and thus damaged a rug in the camp.
