AN ACT Providing Funds to Increase Payments to Boarding Homes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Welfare the sum of \$300,000 to increase the payments made to boarding homes for defectives and for the aged for services to persons receiving state aid. The breakdown shall be as follows:

1972-73

DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND WELFARE

Boarding Homes

All Other

\$300,000

Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 1972.
