SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 712, L. D. 1986, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Revenue Sharing and Financial Relief to Counties for Expenses of the Superior and Supreme Judicial Courts."

Amend said amendment in that part designated "§163." by striking out all of subsection 4 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'4. Balance to counties. After paying the expenses
incurred by the operation of this chapter, the Treasurer of
State shall pay semi-annually the excess to the counties of the
State in the proportion which the population of each bears to
the total population of the State, according to the latest
available Federal Census. The assumption of the expenses by
the State for the operation of the District, Superior and
Supreme Judicial Courts shall not result in any net loss of
revenue to any county, provided that the expenses of a county
so assumed by the State shall be taken into account based on the year 1971.

Further amend said amendment by striking out all of the last paragraph before the Statement of Fact and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Further amend said Bill by inserting after section 12 the following:

Sec. 13. R. S., T. 14, § 1215, amended. Section 1215 of Title 14 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 391 of the public laws of 1971, is amended by adding at the end the following new sentence:

(Filing no. \$-373)

The mileage and-compensation of jurors under this section shall be paid by the State.

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections 5 to 30 to be sections 7 to 33.1

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide that no county shall lose revenue because of the operation of the Bill.
