
SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 714, L. D. 1988, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Reporting Tumors and Establishing a State-
wide Tumor Registry."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§ 1402." by inserting
at the end the following new sentence: 'When objection is made
by any person to furnishing such reports because of a conflict
with such person's religious tenents and practice, no report
shall be filed as to that person, nor shall this section be
deemed to apply to any facility conducted by and exclusively
for persons who rely on spiritual means alone through prayer
for healing in the exercise of religious freedom.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides for when an objection is made
to furnishing reports because of a conflict with religious
tenents and practice.
