SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 716, L.D. 1989, Bill, "AN ACT Implementing the Reorganization of the Department of Agriculture."

Amend said Bill in the next to the last and the last lines of section 1 (last line of L.D.) by striking out the following: "and the-Maine-Potato-Marketing-Commission Milk Tax Committee." and inserting in place thereof the following words and punctuation: 'and-the Maine Potato-Marketing Commission, Milk Tax Committee and the Soil and Water Conservation Commission.'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end of section 13 the following:

'Sec. 13-A. R.S., T. 12, § 52 amended. The 2nd sentence of section 52 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

'It With the approval of the Commissioner of the Department of Agriculture, it shall employ an executive director and such other temporary or permanent employees as it may require.'

This amendment transfers the Soil and Water Conservation Commission into the Department of Agriculture.
